


To add the New Ideas Workshop calendar feed to your calendar take the below steps.


Google Calendar:

Open Google Calendar	
Click the “+” next to “Other Calendars”	
Click “From URL”	
Paste the this URL http://events.uconn.edu/api/ical/?calendar%5B%5D=781	



Click "Add to calendar"	
Note that although this should auto-update sometimes it can take 2-4 days to load new events.	


Outlook:

Open Outlook	
Click "Add Calendar"	
Click "Subscribe from web"	
Paste here:	



<p>Title the calendar whatever you like, e.g., “New Ideas in Insurance Workshop”]</p>	
<p>Click “Import”</p>	

Apple Calendar (Desktop):

<p>Open Apple Calendar</p>	
<p>Click File > New Calendar Subscription</p>	
<p>Paste this URL: http://events.uconn.edu/api/ical/?calendar%5B%5D=781</p>	
<p>Click “Subscribe”</p>	
<p>Click “Ok”</p>
